

Trends Post-COVID Public Health Emergency

- Many states that are engaged in roadmap planning have taken a pause to re-evaluate plans
 - Questioning 5-10-year roadmaps for the sake of modularization
 - Taking a critical look at the "why" of modularization and assessing business needs
 - Networking to get best practices and lessons learned from other states
 - Seeking fresh input from the vendor community
 - Assessing the risk of procurement problems on staging and sequencing



Directions

- Business outcomes are more often being described in terms of data – access, availability, quality, accuracy
- The Interoperability Rule has provided a lever for rethinking data strategies and governance
- Sourcing options exist for the integration platform internal SI, project management-heavy, leverage existing assets, separate IP operation, etc.
- States are adjusting plans to get incremental outcomes and reconsidering true need to replace systems
- Looking for sustainable technology that supports forward movement, even in the face of serious delays or problems
